Those in attendance were Mrs. Granada – Principal, Carrie Peterson – President, Cherie Hall – Treasurer, and Donna Woodrum – Secretary.

- Secretary's Report – Minutes from December meeting were reviewed and approved.
- Treasurer's Report – The account balance as of 1/31/13 is \$1,222.58. \$124.00 was donated for the Teacher/Staff Appreciation Breakfast. After expenses there was a profit of \$2.43, so we feel that this was a success! Thank you to everyone who donated!!
- Principal's Report – East High School was the HS chosen to be visited by the Accreditation Team for the District. They should be at the school next Tuesday.
- Other Business – The Juniors ACT test is Tuesday, March 5th. This will be a Digital Day of Learning for other students. It was decided to follow through with the idea of asking the sophomore class to sponsor the breakfast for the juniors with the mindset that they will be the class benefiting from this system next year. It also determined that we will ask for monetary donations, like we did with the Teacher/Staff breakfast. This will enable us to better plan items to be purchased. Carrie will get with Patty on making a One Call just for the sophomore students about this request. Mrs. Granada offered to allow us to offer a onetime waiver of the \$85.00 student activity fee for the 2013-14 school year to be given away randomly to one student whose parent donates at least \$20.00 to the breakfast. This is a great incentive for donations and is greatly appreciated. Thank you Mrs. Granada! Carrie is also going to speak to Sam's Club about possible donations. During the week of Valentine's Day, weather permitting, Carrie may sell candy and/or flowers at the high school as a fundraiser for PTSCO. It was decided that we will finalize the details of the ACT breakfast via email as our next meeting will be near the test date.
